16-19 Bursary Fund for the Academic Year 2024-25

Purpose of the Fund

The purpose of the 16-19 Bursary Fund is to provide financial help to learners who are facing financial barriers to participating in their studies. Abbot Beyne School is able to make Bursary Fund allocations based on the needs of individual students, taking into account their individual circumstances.

Allocation

In 2024/25 the school will receive a 16-19 Bursary Fund allocation for Discretionary Bursaries only. The funding for Vulnerable Student Bursaries will be held centrally by the Learner Support Service within the Education & Skills Funding Agency (ESFA).

Criteria for allocation

The money can only be allocated to students on an individual basis against the criteria set out below. All students aged 16 or over studying in the Sixth Form are eligible to apply if they feel they meet the criteria.

Discretionary Bursary

Students who have financial barriers affecting participation in their studies may apply for assistance towards the cost of transport, meals, books and equipment, if any of the following apply:

- They are not eligible for the Vulnerable Students Bursary
- Their household income is £30,000 or less after deductions
- They would meet the criteria for eligibility for free school meals
- Unexpected hardship as a result of a change in circumstances at the discretion of the Bursary Panel.

Students must also meet all the targets and objectives in their Sixth Form Learning Agreement.

Any Bursary Fund Allocations awarded by the Bursary Panel will be a contribution towards the cost and may not cover the whole cost. Documentary evidence and receipts will be required as appropriate.

Administration

Applications will be accepted any time during the academic year.

Payment for the Discretionary Bursary will be discussed and arranged on an individual basis. "Payment in kind" may be considered appropriate, e.g. for books, course materials and travel passes.

5% of the Bursary Fund can be retained to assist with administration costs.

Monitoring and Evaluation

The Director of Post-16, Laura Pollitt, will be responsible for ensuring students meet targets and objectives as per their Learning Agreement. Failure to do so can result in the funding being withdrawn.

The Bursar will be responsible for maintaining records in accordance with the requirements of the ESFA.

The Bursar will be responsible for reporting to the ESFA as appropriate.

The 16-19 Bursary Fund Policy will be reviewed on an annual basis by the Governors Policy and Finance Committee.

Appeals

Applicants should be aware that funding available for the Discretionary Bursary is limited. The Bursary Panel will consider all applications received but reserve the right to award funding as the Panel sees appropriate.

The Governors Appeals Committee will receive and determine upon any appeals where funding is refused. Appeals should be addressed to the Clerk of the Governors c/o the school.
